Celebrate Opening Day with a Blast from the SGLS

On Saturday April 8th at 7:00, the Taylor SportsPlex will become a concert venue as the Southern Great Lakes Symphony presents: **The Wide World of Sports and Music.**

The orchestra under the direction of Music Director Charles Greenwell will feature sports tunes such as the *Olympic Fanfare*, the score from *The Natural*, *Chariots of Fire* and *Field of Dreams* and the work John Williams wrote for the Utah Olympics-*Summon the Heroes*.
